FIRST AID:



FLOOR COATING COMPATIBILITY:


This disinfectant is safe to use on Pioneer Eclipse floor coatings when correctly diluted and used according to the product directions.

If disinfectant applied is too concentrated, it will dull and start to degrade the finish.

If additional coats of finish are to be applied to floors treated with a disinfectant, they either must be cleaned with ReBoot™ Deep Scrub Floor Cleaner or completely stripped.

Pioneer Eclipse floor coatings can continue to be burnished and maintained as normal, even after disinfection.

DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Rinse hard, non-porous food contact surfaces with potable water after application of product. This product is not for use on medical device surfaces.

FOR USE AS A GENERAL, HOSPITAL, MEDICAL DISINFECTANT, FUNGICIDE, VIRUCIDE*, CLEANER, DEODORIZER:

Pre-clean heavily soiled areas. Apply use solution of 0.5 oz. of this product per gal. of water to disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces with a sponge, brush, cloth, mop, by immersion, auto scrubber, mechanical spray device. For spray applications, spray 6-8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Allow to air dry. Rinsing of floors is not necessary unless they are to be waxed or polished. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when visibly dirty.

Prepare a use solution of 0.5 oz. of this product per gal. of water for effectiveness against designated animal viruses on the label.

FOR USE AS AN ANIMAL PREMISE DISINFECTANT/VIRUCIDE**:

Prepare a use solution of 2.25 oz. of this product per gal. of water for effectiveness against designated animal viruses on the label. Apply use solution to disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces with a sponge, brush, cloth. Immerse all halters and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals, as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used for removing litter and manure in the use solution. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Ventilate buildings, coops and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers and other treated equipment which can contact food or water with soap or detergent, and rinse with potable water before reuse.

NON-FOOD CONTACT SURFACE SANITIZING:

Pre-clean heavily soiled areas. Add 0.5 oz. of this product per gal. of water. Apply solution to hard, non-porous surfaces with a sponge, brush, cloth, mop, by immersion, auto scrubber, mechanical spray device. For spray applications, spray 6-8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 3 minutes. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when visibly dirty.

TO CONTROL MOLD/MILDEW:

Pre-clean heavily soiled areas. Prepare use solution by adding 0.5 oz. of this product per gal. of water. Apply use solution to hard, non-porous surfaces for 10 minutes which will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and their odors. Repeat treatment every seven days, or more often if new growth appears.

NON-ACID TOILET BOWL AND URINAL DISINFECTANT DIRECTIONS

Remove heavy soil prior to disinfection. From a Concentrate: Add 0.5 oz. of this product directly into the water in the toilet bowl. Brush thoroughly over exposed surfaces and under the rim with a toilet brush/mop, cloth, or sponge. Allow solution to stand for 10 minutes and flush. From a Use Solution: Empty water out of toilet bowl or urinal and apply use solution prepared by adding 0.5 oz. of this product per gal. of water to exposed surfaces, including under the rim with a toilet brush/mop, cloth, or sponge. For spray applications, spray 6-8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray. Brush or swab thoroughly, then allow solution to stand for 10 minutes and flush.
